



## **Exclusive: Perpetual Group Executive of Operations Resigns**

FST Media has exclusively learned Perpetual is facing a further senior reshuffle with Matt Pancino, Group Executive of Operations, resigning from the wealth management firm. The news comes hot on the heels of Chief Executive David Deverall's resignation last month.

A company spokesperson confirmed that Pancino's replacement is Michael Miller, Perpetual's former business unit Chief Financial Officer. Miller will assume the new title of Group Executive, Superannuation and Operations. Miller has been with Perpetual for eight years.

It is understood Pancino resigned from the top operational job to join a financial services organisation in November. Pancino was not available to confirm or deny the reports.

Pancino's more recent career highlights have included the successful implementation of Perpetual's two IT consolidation overhauls, *Project Beethoven* and *MyClient*. Pancino also held the role of CIO of Business and Government at Telstra and at Ticketek.
